The New Adventures Day Camp is celebrating our twentieth year of operation! We are honored to have been able to meet and serve so many families in the Marine Park area over these many years. Many of our former campers are now young adults and more than a few have come back to work with our camp. The guiding philosophy of our camp continues to be that all children, provided with a safe and nurturing environment, will flourish by exploring the rich and unique opportunities New York City and the tri-state region have to offer. Our facility includes a special children's playground, gymnasium, a classroom for arts and crafts, a media room and a large lunchroom for games and other activities. All swimming (instructional and recreational) will take place at the PacPlex Swim Club as well as the pool at Jones Beach. This summer, we will again offer a quality gymnastics experience at the Brooklyn Gymnastics Center. In addition, we will be able to utilize the extensive park facilities adjacent to PS 222 as well as Marine Park. We will also take advantage of the many resources of the New York metropolitan area through a variety of day trips. For our older campers, we offer overnight trips to Pennsylvania and Club Getaway in Kent, Connecticut.

While we are focused on the needs of our campers, we are also well aware of the daily issues facing working parents. We have created a schedule that is flexible for parents with the option of selecting from **two to eight week sessions** and **three to five days** per week.

The New Adventures Day Camp offers three different choices for your child based on his/her grade in September, 2017. **Pathfinders** (entering Pre-K through Four), **Voyagers** (entering grades Five to Six) and **Teen Trek** (entering grades Seven to Ten). Please look through the brochure to find out more about each program. **We require that all parents provide an email address** so the camp can communicate with you. Parents are asked to download and complete all camp forms on our website that apply to your child. PATHFINDERS (entering grades *Pre- K to Four in September 2017*)

In our Pathfinders camp, campers will experience an adventurous summer of activities using the facilities at PS 222, the PACPLEX Swim Club, the Brooklyn Gymnastics Center, Marine Park and area attractions. Daily activities will be tailored to the skill levels and interests of the various age groupings. These activities include: sports, arts and crafts, music, drama, karate, dance, chess and nature exploration. Swimming is an integral part of our program with instructional as well as recreational swim. All campers are taught to swim by Red Cross certified Water Safety Instructors. Each week there are day trips to local places of interest including: bowling, baseball games, museums, amusement parks, Jones Beach Pool, the Marine Park Nature Center and other attractions.

Key staff members are trained in CPR and First Aid. Fees include lunch, snack, camp T-shirt, backpack and admission to all activities. Free camp photo for all campers. **Please note that Pre-K campers must be four years of age when camp begins.**

VOYAGERS (entering grades Five and Six in September 2017)

The Voyagers program is built around the growing sense of independence and a desire to explore new interests in the preteen years. In recognition of the special interests of this age group, the Voyagers camp features a combination of local activities, day trips and overnight excursions. Daily activities are comprised of sports, swimming, creative and fine arts. Daily trips include: amusement parks, baseball games, museums, Jones Beach Pool and extended trips. There are two overnight trips this summer to Pennsylvania and Club Getaway in Connecticut.

Registration: Please fill out the enclosed registration form completely and be sure to sign the parent agreement on the back. **Please make sure to clearly fill out your email address.** We will not accept registration forms that are unsigned and/or received without a full deposit. A deposit of \$500 per camper is required at time of enrollment. Payment may be made by cash, check, money order or credit card. Full payment is due on or before **Friday, June 2, 2017.** **Please note that Early Bird full payment is due by March 31, 2017.** No camper will be allowed to attend camp with an unpaid balance. **ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS MUST BE MADE PAYABLE TO WORKING PARENTS ALLIANCE.** **There will be a \$100 service charge added to camp registration received after June 2, 2017.**

Discounts: We offer a variety of discounts which are detailed below. Check to see which ones you are eligible for!

- ***Early Bird:*** Parents who register and complete full payment by **Friday, March 31st, 2017** are eligible for a \$200 discount per camper for the full eight week session. Campers registering for four to seven weeks will receive a \$175 discount. **Failure to pay in full by March 31, 2017 will result in cancellation of your Early Bird status.** Discounts are based on a five day week for eight weeks. **Fewer days and weeks are prorated.**
- ***Sibling:*** A \$200 discount is available for each additional camper from the same family attending five days per week for eight weeks. Campers attending four to seven weeks will receive a \$175 discount. Discounts are based on a five day week. **Fewer days and weeks will be prorated.**
- ***Referral:*** If you refer a new camp family that registers for four weeks or more, you are eligible for a \$100 discount. **Discounts are based on a five day week. Fewer days will be prorated.** Two referrals per family maximum.

Early Morning and Late Stay Options: The Early Morning drop-off service runs from 7:45-8:30AM. The fee is \$4 per day. The Late Stay Service runs from 5:00-6:00 PM with a fee of \$6 per day. Any camper picked up beyond 6:00 PM will be subject to a \$1 late fee per minute.

Bus Pick-Up and Drop-Off: Morning and evening transportation service is available to our campers, subject to location. Pick up and drop off times are determined by the transportation provider based on area and distance from the camp. Transportation is door to door wherever possible. If door to door is not available, such as dead end streets or ongoing construction, another nearby location will be chosen and those families will be notified. If you are interested in this service, please fill out the requested information. The morning and evening locations must be the same. A camp counselor is on all buses to ensure a safe trip for your child.

Once camp begins, there will be no refunds made except for reasons due to illness accompanied by a physician's statement. If registering for less than five days per week, all days must be the same each week. I understand that days and weeks may not be swapped. The Working Parents Alliance reserves the right, after due notification to the parent/guardian to cancel any camper enrollment or dismiss a camper whose conduct or behavior is deemed unsatisfactory to the best interests of the camp. There will be no refunds given for such dismissal. I authorize the camp to use my child's photograph in publicity and news releases at its discretion. I agree to allow my child to participate in all camp trips and activities. I understand the camp will not administer medication to my child except for routine first aid needs. I understand that the day camp is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items. Finally, I understand that the Working Parents Alliance (NADC), its officers, agents or employees will not be responsible for any accident or injury unless arising out of negligence or willful misconduct of its personnel.
